






Chris, Joy, and Gizmo were excited to go to the Mall for the Annual Christmas Eve Scramble up Prize Peak!

Chris felt sad for him, but his excitement was overtaken with joy as his winning ticket number was announced.




Chris' jumping for joy was momentarily interrupted. Superbook suddenly showed up to take them back in time.

Chris, Joy, and Gizmo also met Joseph and Mary. Joseph had to take Mary to his town of Bethlehem to register.




Mary and Joseph traveled far to get to Bethlehem. It was a very tiring trip for Mary for she was going to have a baby.



When they reached the town, all the inns were full and there was nowhere they could stay.




Finally, someone offered them a place for the night, a lowly manger.




**That night a wonderful thing happened: Mary had a baby! But this wasn't just any baby, he was Emmanuel!
The King of Kings!**




The little baby boy fell asleep in Mary's arms. She wrapped him in cloths and laid him in a manger.




An angel appeared to the shepherds in the nearby field announcing the good news of Jesus' birth.




Finally, the wise men found Jesus and offered Him gifts of gold, myrrh, and frankincense.




Superbook taught Chris that God so loved the world that He sacrificially gave His only Son to save the world. It was now time to go back.




Chris came back learning and realizing that giving is an expression of love and that Jesus is the best example of this sacrifice.



Chris excitedly claimed his prize and to everyone's surprise gave it to the boy, who he felt, would appreciate it more.




